### Call of the Wild

High-end ranches court corporate groups

Holding a corporate retreat or meeting at a high-end guest ranch combines the best of both worlds: a true wilderness setting and the conveniences of a city-based facility. Two standouts are Devil's Thumb Ranch ([devilsthumbbranch.com](http://devilsthumbbranch.com)), in Tabernash, Colo., and The Resort at Paws Up ([pawsup.com](http://pawsup.com)), in Greenough, Mont. In addition to meeting rooms and state-of-the-art A/V equipment, both venues feature spas and individual luxury cabins. Devil's Thumb also offers more affordable Lodge rooms, while Paws Up has luxury tents. Both are open year-round and offer abundant outdoor activities for incentive retreats, conferences and corporate team-building. Groups at Paws Up can rent the entire 37,000-acre ranch, including all 28 vacation homes (a total of 73 bedrooms and 66 bathrooms), for \$15,000 a day in September and October, which comes to less than 41 cents an acre.
