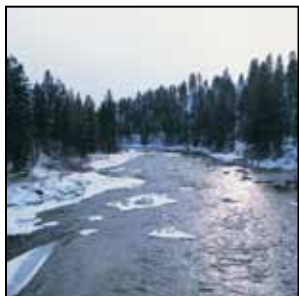

You'll hit the trail behind a team of guided sled dogs for an exhilarating ride. You'll witness working dogs at their powerful best as you dash through the fresh Montana powder. Each sled accommodates two riders, and if conditions are ideal, you may be able to join the guide on the skis for a go at mushing (driving the dogs forward).

Shooting Sports



Sporting Clays is a challenging, wildly fun, and competitive clay target game that simulates actual field hunting. Shoot on specially designed courses that resemble real-life field conditions; the lure of

the game lies in its incredible realism. At Paws Up, our Sporting Clays installation features a 12-station course* that throws a diversity of aerial target presentations. The clays cross, climb, zip in, fly out, or streak high overhead at speeds and angles accurately simulating the flight patterns of game birds. The course is divided into stations that are identifiable by the game they are designed to imitate, such as Quail Flushing into Woodland, Rabbit Bouncing for Cover, Ducks Landing in a Swamp, or Doves Whistling High Overhead. Sporting Clays is indeed a game that puts a shot gunner's abilities to

the ultimate test. For beginners and experts alike, you are bound to have a blast.

The speed may take your breath away, but not to worry – it's a quick run with a forgiving "landing pad." No stumps or rocks to bounce over, no trees to run into. of whimsy, and, for a time, the release of all earth-bound concerns. At times, passengers on the “Mountain Butterfly” will merely hover inches above the green summer grass; or flow smoothly over the rolling terrain like a silent roller-coaster, just brushing the crowns of Ponderosa Pines. At other times, you will find yourself brushing the soft grey bottom of a wandering cloud or two; or cruising above them and observing the rainbow-colored halo set around the sun-cast shadow of your balloon for an experience-of-a-lifetime.

Note: All flights begin at sunrise, as this is the coolest, and most stable, time of the day. It is our intent to be airborne for no less than one hour, likely longer, but cannot be guaranteed. Appropriate landing sites are not always available for our convenience, or our schedule. We must find them (which is part of the fun). Safety is our primary concern. Last minute alterations or cancelations due to weather concerns are always possible.
