The Paws Up “Kids Corps of Discovery” is held seven days a week. Full and half-day programs\* are available for children ages 5 to 12. Programs will include organized, themed activities with age-appropriate crafts and daily feedings of the baby animals at the Cow Pokes’ Corral. Daily themes and excursions include the following:

### MONDAY – LEWIS AND CLARK DAY

*Daily activities will include:* Petting zoo, learn the basics of map and compass reading, scavenger hunt, Lewis and Clark matching game, flag making and designing, hiking and exploring the wilderness learning the basics of fire building, knot-tying, and how to build a lean-to.

### TUESDAY – FUN IN THE SUN AT SEELEY LAKE

Located 20 miles north of Paws Up ranch is the cozy town of Seeley Lake. Enjoy a variety of safe outdoor water excursions under the watchful eye of our First Aid and CPR certified staff.

*Daily activities will include:* Paddle boat and kayak excursions, motor boat rides, swimming, dock fishing, water trampoline, and water games!

### WEDNESDAY – A DAY AT THE RANCH

Here's the chance to be a real cowboy or cowgirl!

*Daily activities will include:* Petting zoo, paint your own cowboy hat to wear, horseshoe painting, nature hike, tour the Equestrian Center, rope tying and lasso techniques, pony rides, horse painting (Yes! Children get to paint a REAL horse!), and a wagon ride.

### THURSDAY – IT'S GOLD RUSH DAY!

Go back in time and walk the streets of a real ghost town and pan for gold in a crystal clear mountain stream just like the miners of old!

*Daily activities will include:* Petting zoo, gold panning, a trip to historic Garnet Ghost town, a scavenger hunt, and play the Smuggler and Sleeping Miser games!

### FRIDAY – WILD MONTANA!

Spend a day immersed in the wonders of nature among the untouched wilderness accompanied by an expert naturalist guide.

*Daily activities will include:* Petting zoo, nature hike, microscopic examination of wildflowers and insects, flower pressing, plankton catching and examining, animal tracking expedition, cast and paint your favorite animal tracks to take home, and fishing/casting lesson.

### SATURDAY – GO TRIBAL!

Take a journey back in time and spend the day immersed in the culture and traditions of Montana's first residents. Children will have an experience of a lifetime leaving them with a deeper understanding and appreciation for the Native Americans.

*Daily activities will include:* Petting zoo, hike through the woods in search of plants and roots utilized by various tribes in the area, create and design your own headdress, moccasins and rain sticks to take home, go on an arrowhead hunt, beading and jewelry making, teepee building, rattle creations, and face painting.

### SUNDAY – ART IN MONTANA

Watch the artist emerge as youthful creativity takes shape in artwork based on interesting objects and patterns found in nature.

*Daily activities will include:* Petting zoo, pinch pot creations, nature walk-including river rock and walking stick finding, natural frame making, jewelry making and designing, and paint! paint! paint!-pinch pots, river rocks, and walking sticks.
