- Work with Glamping Supervisors in reviewing daily occupancy reports and evening dining activity reports to prepare Butlers for arrivals, special guest requests and service expectations for the day
- Visit with guests and converse with guests at a high level, being aware of their needs and fulfilling special requests as instructed by management or guests directly
- Attend appropriate Resort meetings and represent Glamping Operations
- Manage glamping teams to achieve an exceptional level of efficiency and quality as they relate to glamping, food and beverage and luxury service
- Place food, beverage and supply orders
- Provide dining service to guests at Dining Pavilions
- Assist in scheduling regular interdepartmental meetings following guest stays to assess successes and areas where improvements can be made for future stays
- Schedule staff according to volume of business; understand how to flex when necessary to meet labor expectations; adjust daily operations to be in line with budget
- Maintain cleanliness of vehicles and glamping sites
- Keep up-to-date knowledge on all menu items including preparation, any allergens and alternative preparations; Communicate food restrictions to Food & Beverage and Culinary teams
