Wilderness Estates

Just a short drive from the Paws Up Village, the 10 Wilderness Estates offer sweeping views of the ranch and surrounding forests. Each spacious 3,250-square-foot home features three primary suites with private baths, making them perfect for up to three couples seeking shared moments while enjoying separate quarters. These estates include an outdoor hot tub, a large stone fireplace, a full kitchen, a laundry room, Wi-Fi, and the use of a Lexus SUV. Set on four private acres of wooded land, they offer a secluded and peaceful retreat.



Big Timber Homes

Nestled in scenic woods, the 10 Big Timber Homes provide a classic Montana escape. Each home welcomes guests with a wide front porch and a private deck featuring an outdoor hot tub. With kitchenettes, washers and dryers, Wi-Fi, and the use of a Lexus SUV, these homes are ideal for both relaxation and adventure. Glamping

There's nothing quite like sleeping under the stars and being surrounded by nature. Paws Up is North America's premier glamping destination, offering six luxury camps designed for all kinds of groups. Each safari-style tent features comfortable furnishings, electricity, heat, air-conditioning, and daily cleaning with turn-down service. Private en suite bathrooms include spacious rain showers and heated floors.

With 36 safari-style tents across the six camps, most groups opt for one tent per couple or individual. For larger gatherings, tents with two or three bedrooms provide a more communal experience. At Paws Up, luxury and the great outdoors come together for an unforgettable escape.

Paws Up's Glamping tents are available from mid-May through mid-October.





Dining Pavilion

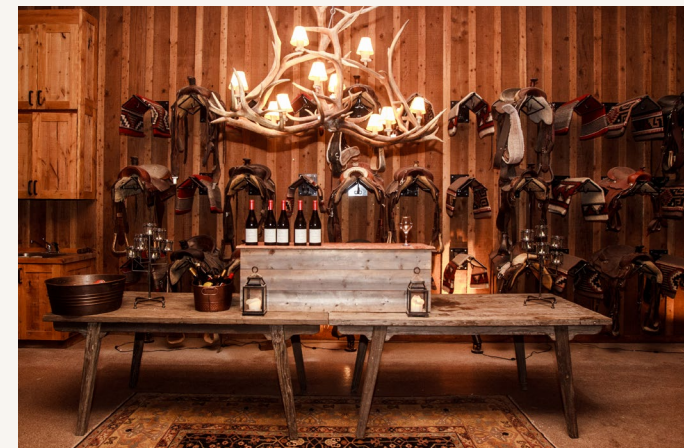
The Sky Box

Fresh salads, sides, and a variety of decadent desserts round out the offerings. Open for breakfast, lunch, and dinner.



Adventures

Experience Montana’s ever-changing landscape at Paws Up, where adventure awaits every season. In spring, marvel at rushing, snow-fed waters and wildflower meadows; in fall, be enchanted by shimmering tamaracks and the lively spirit of rainbow trout.
